SOCIAL DISTANCING MEASURES



From July 1, it is not obligatory to wear masks in public with the following exceptions:

- It is mandatory to wear face masks in Prague metro.
- It is requested to wear masks in public transport and the interiors of the regions and places that saw some local spike



While entering restaurants, cafés and bars, you are recommended to:

- Disinfect your hands upon entry
- Maintain a distance of at least 1.5 meters from the staff and other customers
- Pay by card, preferably contactless, whenever possible



Hotels, restaurants, shops, exchange offices and tourist information centers are open.

Increased hygienic measures are applied to protect visitors and employees as follows:

- providing protective equipment and health check for its employees
- -covering elevator buttons, handles, touchable public handles with washable and protective plastic
- -replacing buffet breakfast tables with individually breakfast/wrapped breakfast package
- providing sanitizers throughout the hotels
- developing training for the staff for handling emergency/COVID-19 related situations with a health care hotline and service

CZECH REPUBLIC HEALTH STATUS

HIGH PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

Medical care in the Czech Republic is on a very good professional and technological level while results of Czech doctors in some fields can be considered as top-ranking worldwide. The Czech health care system is ranked as number 14 on the Euro Consumer Health Care Index - one of the best performers among Central Eastern European countries.

The health system is based on a Social Health Insurance (SHI) scheme with compulsory membership of an insurance fund and its universal coverage, a generous benefit package, and a strong regulatory role for the Ministry of Health.

COVID-19 TESTING IS AVAILABLE at the Prague Václav Havel International Airport

Testing is performed by an accredited GHC Genetics laboratory in order to facilitate the safe travelling of passengers on both arrivals and departures directly at the airport (three locations in the public space as well as in the transit zone).

The taking of samples at the check points is performed on a queue basis. Alternatively, passengers and other interested parties can book a time in advance on the telephone number +420 739 500 500 or via e-mail covid@ghc.cz.

The price for the standard RT-PCR COVID-19 test is 65 EUR (1,750 CZK). The price for express performance of the test with delivery of results within three hours is 280 EUR (7,500 CZK). The surcharge for confirmation of test results by a doctor, if requested by the passenger, is 20 EUR (550 CZK). Payment is accepted at all three check points, via debit cards and cash, using Czech crowns or Euros.

In the case of COVID-19 confirmed case, the person in question is obliged to follow the self-isolation/quarantine measures prescribed by the health care authorities.

HOSPITALS

A total of over 1,000 beds are available for use in infectious disease wards all over the Czech Republic (incl. a specialized and highly qualified unit at Na Bulovce Hospital). If this capacity were to be exhausted, facilities which do not primarily provide care for infectious patients would be activated and adapted to suit this purpose.

PRAGUE AIRPORT

Travelers arriving from "green zone" COVID-19 safe countries are checked for the symptoms. Others need to proceed immediately COVID-19 testing and contact the local health authorities within 72 hours upon arrival. Otherwise they are obliged to follow the quarantine regulations. Prague Airport's check-in desks have been equipped with protective barriers - films for safe contact between the passenger and the check-in agent. Hand sanitizers are available in all public areas of the airport.
